

The race for Men Elite, Men Junior, Women Elite, and Women Junior is a **UCI C3 race**. The race is also the first round of the Cyprus National MTB Cup series and will be held as per the UCI and Cyprus Cycling Federation regulations.

SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

1- CATEGORIES

The following categories may compete:

- UCI C3 RACE:
 - Men Elite, Women Elite, Men Junior, Women Junior.
- CYPRUS NATIONAL MTB CUP SERIES:
 - Men Elite, Women Elite, Men Junior, Women Junior, Cadet boys U17, Cadet girls U17, Cadet boys U15, Cadet girls U15, Masters Men 1,2,3 & Masters Women 1,2,3
- CYCLING FOR ALL (OPEN RACE):
 U19 Boys, U19 Girls, 19-39 Men, 19-39 Women, 40+ Men, 40+ Women

2- Course & Map

4,4 Km XCO route with 125m of altitude gain per lap, in the beautiful forest of Lythrodontas

3- FEED AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ZONES

There will be 3 feed and technical assistance zones:

- FTA 1 (2 km to go): Double FTA next to the Start/Finish area (same as FTA 3).
- FTA 2 (900m to go): it can be accessed by 4x4 car or on foot > 500m walk from the Start / Finish area. Parking space will be provided outside the course and must be respected.
- FTA 3 (100m to go): Double FTA next to the Start/Finish area (same as FTA 1).

4- TIMING

Timing will be done with the Mylaps timing transporter chips. Riders are obliged to return their timing chip after their race. Riders who fail to return their chip face a penalty of €80.

5- SCHEDULE

OBLIGATORY ONSITE COVID-19 DETECTION RAPID ANTIGEN TEST FOR ALL THE ATHLETES ABOVE 18 YEARS OLD.

UNDERAGE RIDERS WILL BE TESTED IF THEY WISH TO DO SO.

RIDERS WITHOUT A RAPID NEGATIVE TEST, WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ENTER THE RACE VENUE AND RACE.

RIDERS MUST PRESENT THEMSELVES FOR A TEST 1,5 HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE RACE.

Riders Confirmations, Race Number and timing chip distribution at the race venue. Team Managers pick up the Race Numbers and Timing Chips for the whole team. Race Number and timing chip distribution for each race, closes 30 minutes before the start.

6:15pm	Awards Ceremony for Third Race at the Start/Finish area. First 5 Riders on the podium
6:30 Prize	Money Distribution at the Start-Finish area after the award ceremony.

13- Measures to reduce the risks of exposure and spread of the virus that causes Covid-19

- > NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RACE VENUE AND AROUND THE COURSE
